Membership Policies

Regular Membership	Regular members are individuals with a business/location represented on the website/map. Regular members pay the full annual membership fee, have a dedicated page on the Peninsula Potters website and are expected to participate in promotional activities for the BHPP.
Group Membership	Group memberships are defined as two or more individuals operating under one name/location and are represented as such, on the website/map. They will pay one regular membership fee for the first group member and an additional \$50 for each group member thereafter. It is up to the individual group to decide who is a joining member and how to divide the membership fee total. Groups will have a dedicated page on our website, with photos of work credited to individual members of the group. Groups are expected to participate in promotional activities for the BHPP, though how each group chooses to do so is up to them.
Guest Membership	Guest members pay an annual fee of \$75 to participate in either one or both Annual Tour shows at the location of a regular member. Guest members will be represented on a separate "Tour Guest" tab on our website and will not be expected to participate in meetings or promotional activities.
